Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 12 (four sections each in Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). Since the school is already running more number of sections in Bal Vatika – III, it is directed to reduce the number of sections in the same. The total number of sections of the school from class I to X shall be restricted to 48. The optimum number of students shall be restricted to 40 in each section.
2	The composite science lab has multiple small cubicles / workstation, which makes the lab congested and it will be difficult for a CwSN for easy access.
